- 2. Qualifying non-profit group living facilities, agricultural employee housing facilities, and migrant farm work housing centers are eligible for credits as shown on **Schedule CAP**.
- Water and Power Expense Increase: Beginning on July 31, 2023, rates in this area will (T) reflect a 8.9% revenue increase (as compared to the revenue approved in Advice Letter 2454) due to higher charges by the Santa Clara Valley Water District (Valley Water) and (C) Pacific Gas and Electric Company. This caused quantity rates to go up by \$0.6453 /CCF. (C) Amounts collected from this quantity rate increase will be tracked in a balancing account, as required by Section 792.5 of the Public Utilities Code. Monthly service (T) charges also went up, with the charge for a 5/8 x ¾-inch meter increasing by \$2.00. (C)
