Power Expense Increase: Beginning on July 31, 2023, rates in this area will reflect a 1.9% revenue increase (as compared to the revenue approved in Advice Letter 2437) due to higher charges by Pacific Gas and Electric Company. This caused quantity rates to go up by \$0.0781 /CCF. Amounts collected from this quantity rate increase will be tracked in a balancing account, as required by Section 792.5 of the Public Utilities Code. Monthly service charges also went up, with the charge for a 5/8 x ¾-inch meter increasing by \$0.48.
