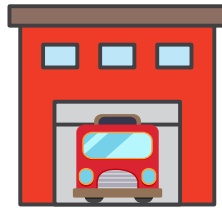




2020 California Water Service Firefighter Grant Program by the Numbers

\$148,500

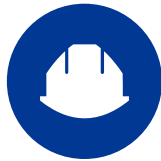


Since 2019, more than

 hydraulic rescue tool, also known as Jaws of Life



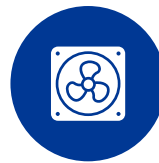
Russian River Fire Protection District:
