

## **2020** California Water Service Firefighter Grant Program by the Numbers



7 applicants awarded grants of \$5,000-\$30,000 for a total of \$148,500



Since 2019, more than \$308,000 in grants awarded to 17 fire departments

These grants were awarded to help firefighters purchase gear or life-saving equipment that would keep themselves and our communities safe during an emergency



Bakersfield Fire Department: a utility terrain vehicle, also known as a side-by-side



King City Fire Department: wildland gear/turnouts (personal protective equipment, or PPE)



Northshore Fire Protection District: hydraulic rescue tool, also known as Jaws of Life



Russian River Fire Protection District: portable radios



Selma Fire Department: fire protective clothing, also known as turnouts



Stockton Fire Foundation: particulate barrier hoods



Visalia Fire Department: a long-running, battery-powered Positive Pressure Ventilation (PPV) fan and an extra battery
